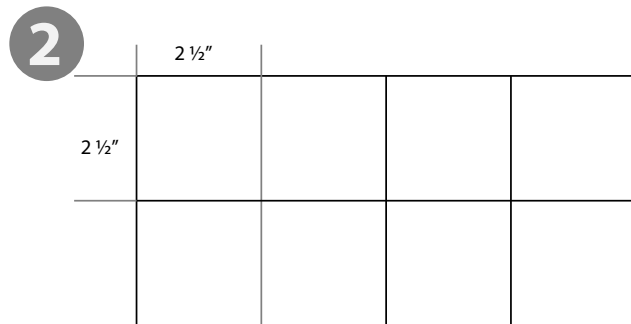


Creating Half-Square Triangles From a 2 1/2" Grid

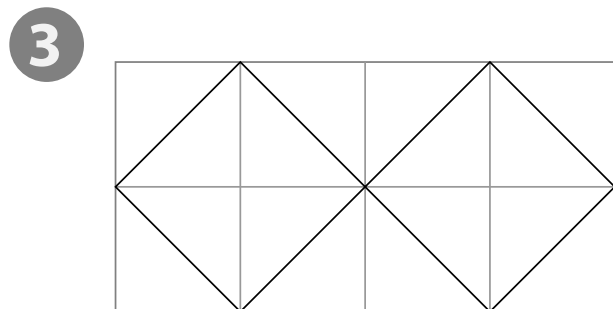
Give A Dog A Bone Supplement



Lay two pieces of fabric – right sides together – on top of each other and press them flat.

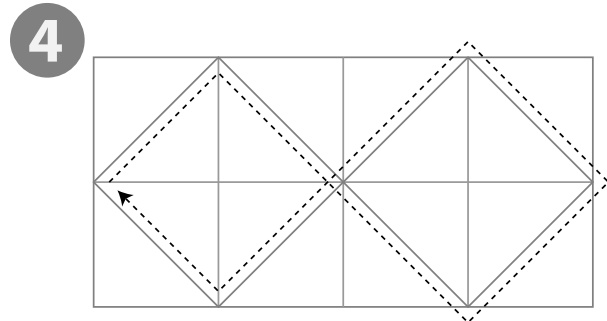


Draw a grid of eight squares each 2 1/2" square as shown above. Make sure to leave at least 1/2" border from any fabric edges.

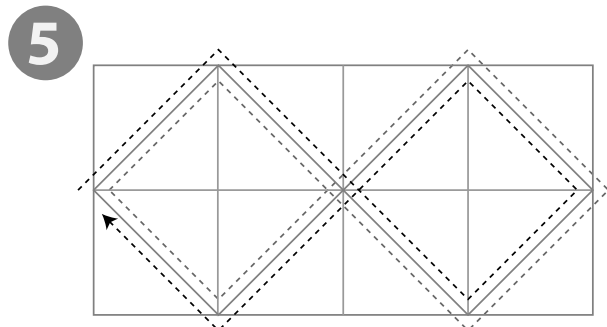


Draw diagonal lines through each of the squares in the pattern shown above.

NOTE: Pin the fabric pieces together according to the video instruction before sewing



Stich a seam 1/4" on one side of the drawn diagonal lines



Stich a seam 1/4" on the other side of the drawn diagonal lines
Cut apart half-square triangles according to the video instruction in this lesson.

NOTE: Press your sewn fabric grid flat before cutting apart the half-square triangles.
